## DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

### Waqf-e-Nau

Alhamdulillah by the grace of Almighty Allah and Sadr Sahiba's guidance this month on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of February Waqfaat-e-Nau along with AMWSA and Umoor-e-Talibaat organised a seminar for over 15 Waqfaat and students.

The main objective of this seminar was to spread awareness among students about the role and responsibilities of Umoor-e-Talibaat/AMWSA departments, and to elevate the physical, spiritual, emotional and mental wellbeing of young lajna.

### Tarbiyyat

The fundamental principle of the Tarbiyyat Department is to draw attention towards good deeds and to remove weaknesses. This includes continuously undertaking efforts for achieving specific targets in terms of promoting good and removing evil through the following goals:

- All members should offer the five daily obligatory prayers and read the Holy Qur'an daily with translation.
- All members should listen to Huzoor's (aba) weekly Friday Sermons.
- To establish, improve and embrace our purdah with pride.
- To guard our children from the dangers of society from a very early age.
- To inculcate Islamic morals in the members of Lajna Imaillah Australia.
- To view and assess all types of Tarbiyyati issues, moral, spiritual and cultural.
- Take necessary measures so that un-Islamic practices and unhealthy customs may not find their way into the Jama'at ladies.
- Try to increase the attendance at Jamaat and Lajna events.

### Khidmat-e-Khalq

In the month of December, a total of 36 visits took place by Majalis' extra effort, with the overall attendance of 145 members. These visits usually included the donation or the presentation of gifts to places such as nursing homes, community centre, religious places.

Donations by the effort of Majlis totalled \$1,395 with additional food and clothing items. A total of 129 members participated.

An email was sent regarding the initiation of keeping a Blood Register of willing individuals that could be contacted at short notice when in need by Red Cross and hospitals.

Roster and guidelines for cleaning the Mosque and Khilafat Hall was sent to all Sydney Regional and Majlis Presidents via email.

### Taleem-ul-Quran and Waqf-e-Arzi (TAQWA)

From the start of the year we communicated all Majalis in Australia to demonstrate the importance, objectives and goals of department through one on one refresher course with Sydney Majalis and by phone with interstate Majalis. One Ashra Taleem-ul-Quran was held from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018 in which 20 Majalis participated. The TAQWA team have commenced teacher's training classes from 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2019 and 85 members from all over Australia are participating in this class, Alhamdulillah.

### **Centennial celebration of completing 100 years of Lajna Imaillah (1922-2022):**

For this glorious and blessed occasion, special Quran translation teaching classes have commenced from 4<sup>th</sup> of February 2019; 6 of these will be conducted in Urdu and 1 in English (starting from 22<sup>nd</sup> February). 135 members are attending these classes, Alhamdulillah.

Lajna donated non-perishable food, nappies and wipes and received many appreciation and thanks from the Youth Centre.
